

Fraser Lands Church Lytton Christmas Hampers 2025

Thank you for being part of this Christmas Hamper initiative for Lytton. We are preparing Christmas Hampers for some Lytton families & individuals. Each hamper is a tangible way to express God's love & our care for the Lytton community. We want to bring the Lyttonites something special for their holiday celebration. We need a minimum of 50 hampers. Please find the following information pertaining to the completion of the hamper:

Hamper box, Christmas card & wrapping paper pickup (from FLC) date: **From November 2 to 23, 2025**
Completed hamper & Christmas card drop-off (at FLC) deadline: **Before Sunday November 30, 2025**

A general description of the household you are preparing the hamper for will be provided when you pick up your Hamper Box. Please prepare the hamper with the household in mind. Some ideas are provided in the chart below:

ESSENTIAL INGREDIENTS	SUGGESTED ITEMS
- Two Family Games. Can include puzzles (250-500pcs). Do not purchase: Jenga, UNO, playing cards, Scrabble, Monopoly, Dutch Blitz. - Good Quality Chocolates - Higher quality salty snacks such as chips, tortilla chips, corn chips, Pretzels, cheesies etc. Miss Vickie Chips, Hawkins Cheesies, Hard Bite chips, Twiggs are good choices and Canadian made. Pringles are good as packaging is hard and durable. (Note: Do not purchase Costco sized bags. They take up too much space in the box.) - Salsa or Antipasto in non glass containers. (Mild or Medium, not Spicy) - Boxed Cookies in a nice tin or box. - Gourmet Crackers - Canned Spread for crackers. - Beef or Pork Jerky or Pepperoni sticks. BKH Jerky on Fraser Street is a good choice. High quality Singaporean Jerky that is locally made. - Gourmet Tea or Instant Coffee or Coffee Mix. Avoid Asian instant coffee mixes - Christmas ornaments or decorations (non breakable). - Easy to make Christmas Crafts (non breakable) The overall cost of the hamper content should be \$120. No blankets, scarves or gloves. <i>The size of the hamper box is about 12.5" x 12.5" x 16.5"</i>	- Hot Chocolate Mix - Apple Cider Mix - Fruit Jerky - Gum - Lip Balm or Chapstick - Japanese Pocky Sticks - Panettone (in a box, not in a bag) - Christmas crackers (pull apart novelties with prizes inside) - Cereal (festive themed) - Liquid soap (festive themed) - Bar Soap (Designer looking) - Good quality hand cream - Microwave popcorn - Candy Cane - Word Find Activity books or the likes - Paper Napkins (festive themed) - Throat Lozenges - Emergen-C (Vitamin C) - Hand Warmers - Foot Warmers - Canned Sockeye Salmon - Non refrigerated Smoked Salmon - Gingerbread house kit

We want to bless the families generously with the best we can offer. Therefore, it is important that the items we provide are **new, unopened,** and **unexpired.**

Some important things to follow regarding filling and gift wrapping the boxes:

- Fill the box, leaving as little empty space as possible.
- Do not seal, but leave them open, so we can inspect to make sure all items are suitable. We will seal the boxes ourselves after inspection.
- You will notice the boxes have perforated openings for easier handling. Please do not cover these openings. Secure the wrapping paper around the opening with more tape.
- Do not remove the label on the inside lid of the box.



- The top inside flaps are all attached. Please do not cut. We will cut after inspection.
- Please pay attention to how the wrapping paper extends a bit beyond the top and also not cut.
